Administrative Order No. 2018-18 permits Pima County Consolidated Justice Court security officers to carry firearms while on duty provided they meet the ongoing training requirements established by Pima County Consolidated Justice Court, and any future training requirements established by the Administrative Office of the Courts.

Based upon the ongoing Public Health Emergency, the deadline for PCCJC administration to provide the county presiding judge with personnel and certification updates is extended to December 31, 2020.
