WHEREAS, the clients of the Conciliation Court are, by definition, persons involved in family law disputes; and

WHEREAS, persons involved in family law disputes are frequently emotionally stressed and often angry with the other party to the dispute; and


WHEREAS, the court personnel who assist in family law cases have been placed at risk from emotionally upset clients who were carrying weapons,

IT IS ORDERED that no weapons are allowed at the Conciliation Court and that any time a client or potential client or person accompanying a client arrives at the Conciliation Court with a weapon, whether it be a gun, knife, or other weapon, that person shall be required to leave the Conciliation Court office immediately and to secure the weapon outside of the Family Conciliation Court Center prior to returning. The only exception are law enforcement officers responding to a crime or emergency situation.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, in the discretion of Court Security, Contract Security, or Conciliation Court Staff, all persons entering Conciliation Court are subject to additional screening.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, in the event a client, potential client, or person accompanying a client refuses to surrender the weapon, no Conciliation Court session will be held and the Court will be advised of the incident.
