WHEREAS, the Jury Commissioner has requested and received from the Pima County Recorder a list of all persons qualified to vote as of January 1, 2023 and has requested and received from the Department of Transportation a list of all persons at least 18 years of age who have been licensed pursuant to A.R.S. Title 28, Chapter 4, Article 2, and


WHEREAS, the Pima County data processing department has merged the above-reference lists which has created a current master jury list of eligible juror candidates pursuant to A.R.S. 21-301(B), which list is presently stored in data processing equipment, and

WHEREAS, under the One Day/One Trial method of juror management it is estimated that the court will require 150,000 persons for prospective jury service during the next six months.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to A.R.S. 21-301,

IT IS ORDERED that the Jury Commissioner draw from the above-described master jury list the name of 150,000 persons for prospective jury service, said drawing to be held within ten days from this date.
