

The Presiding Judge of the Superior Court is charged with responsibility to exercise administrative supervision over the superior court in the county. Administrative supervision includes authority to establish court security policies and procedures to provide a safe work environment for judicial employees, litigants, and users of the court and to provide decorum in the court facility. The safety of those who participate in the judicial process is essential to serving the citizens and doing justice in all cases. The Presiding Judge is also charged with the responsibility to exercise administrative supervision over the justice of the peace courts in their county.

After further review, the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court finds the security of the court and court personnel will be better served through other legal proceedings. Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that Administrative Orders No. 2025-008 (Superior Court) and 2025-002 (PCCJC) are hereby rescinded and removed from all publication.
